Racing Rules:

1. WCOA race meetings shall be conducted in accordance with International and RYA recommendations, class rules, specific instructions contained in the WCOA statement "Rules for Race Meetings" and local sailing instructions.

2. To be eligible to compete and to be awarded points, every Wanderer must be entered by a paid up member of the WCOA. The WCOA [uk] National Committee reserves the right to require potential entrants to produce evidence of current membership of the WCOA.

3. Every Wanderer must be helmed by either a full or an associate member of WCOA as defined in the Constitution.

4. Every helm must possess valid third party insurance to a minimum of £2,000,000 or higher if required by the local sailing instructions.

5. Whenever one or more Wanderers are entered in a Wanderer fleet by sailing clubs, sailing schools, education establishments, youth organisations, companies which hold current membership of WCOA, the name of the helm and the boat sail number must be notified to the WCOA event organiser at least 24 hours before the start of the race. Only the named helm will be eligible to compete and be awarded points.

All such helms must be able to produce written proof, acceptable to the WCOA event organiser, of their current attendance, membership, or employment, as appropriate, relating to the organisation which they represent.

Where joint ownership is registered with the WCOA only one of the registered owners may helm and be awarded points in each Wanderer race meeting. Notification of joint ownership must be made when joining the WCOA or when renewing membership.

6. Personal buoyancy must be worn by the helm and crew in all racing events. Wet suits do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.

Cruising Notes:

1. Life jackets or personal buoyancy aids are strongly recommended for all boat occupants.

2. Masthead buoyancy is recommended in order to reduce the likelihood of the boat inverting following a capsize. It will also greatly assist in righting the boat.

3. Crews should attend the organiser's cruise briefing prior to departure to obtain up to date weather forecast, details of sailing area and navigational information etc..

4. The crew is totally responsible for the seaworthiness of the boat, all equipment carried and ensuring that it is suitably equipped for the prevailing and forecast conditions.

5. Adequate, current marine insurance is required, including 3rd party cover for a minimum of £2,000,000, for any one incident.

6. Cruise attendees may be asked to produce their WCOA Membership Card/No. by the organiser.

7. Cruises will often require those attending to provide adequate food and drink for the duration of the cruise, the organiser will advise when this is recommended.

9. Outboard engines are useful in the event of boat or rigging problems or in instances where the wind subsides. Anchor and oars are recommended for coastal events.
